# **Expectations of the Successful Applicant**

The Cecil Brown Scholarship provides a unique opportunity for young people on the Monaro to develop their skills, knowledge, and experience in the sheep and wool industry.

To ensure the scholarship delivers value for both the recipient and the broader industry, the successful applicant will be expected to:

### 1. Participate Fully in the Scholarship Program

- Attend the New Zealand study tour as coordinated by the scholarship committee.
- Use the educational funding component for a learning activity of your choice (e.g., training course, workshop, conference, or on-farm experience), approved by the scholarship committee before expenses are incurred.

### 2. Report Back on Your Experience

- Submit a short written report within 12 months summarising your activities, key learnings, and outcomes.
- Give a short presentation at an MFS Field Day or another agreed event to share what you learned with members, sponsors, and the local community.

#### 3. Support Scholarship Promotion

 Provide photos, brief updates, or articles when requested for MFS newsletters, social media, or local media outlets to help promote the scholarship and its sponsors.

#### 4. Represent the Scholarship Professionally

- Acknowledge the Cecil Brown Scholarship and its sponsors when speaking about or publishing information related to your scholarship experience.
- Represent the scholarship and MFS in a professional and positive manner at all events and activities.

### 5. Future Involvement (Optional)

• You may be invited to join the scholarship committee in the following year to share your experience and help guide future recipients.

### 6. Administration and Timelines

- Obtain pre-approval from the scholarship committee for all expenses related to the educational funding component.
- Submit all receipts, reports, and required documentation promptly by agreed deadlines.
- Complete all scholarship activities within 12 months of receiving the award unless alternative arrangements are agreed upon with the scholarship committee.
